


Annual GDP growth

Air Travel Becoming More Diverse Geographically






Airlines will need 34,000 new airplanes valued at \$4.5 trillion by 2031






Asia Pacific air travel growth exceeds world average






Asia Pacific will need 12,030 new airplanes valued at \$1.7 trillion




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
